Creative Assignment: *Choose one of the following...*

Pretend you are a talk show host and interview the main character. You must include the interviewer's questions and the character's responses. There must be 10 questions and 10 responses (i.e. why and how questions). For bonus points, you are welcome to video or audio record this.

OR

Create a trifold travel guide brochure of three specific settings in your novel. Include a cover page, and inside each page should include the setting, a drawing of the location and an explanation of why the setting was significant in the story.

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2021 Summer Reading Project (Grade 7) Cont...
